(We'll have coffee & tea and you're encouraged to bring your own mug)

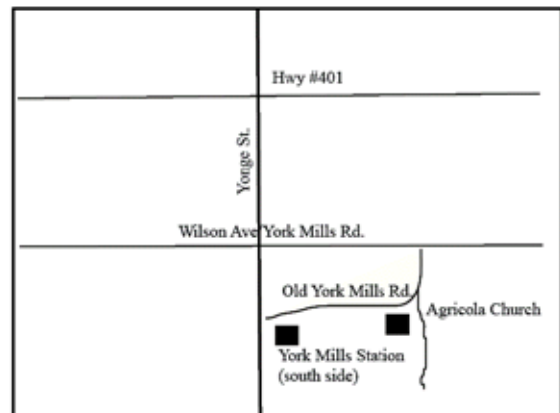
